



Chrome Browser Maintenance

We ask a lot of Google Chrome. This is a friendly reminder about proactively maintaining your Internet Browser (and possibly asking students to also) to minimize unexpected page loading issues.

When you maintenance your cookies and cache, it is also a good time to check the boxes for clearing "Browsing Data" and "Download History" too. This brief video tutorial explains how to [clear your Chrome cookies and cache](#), if you need it.

On the right of this sheet is a list of questions and answers that have been asked in the past regarding Chrome maintenance.

Best Practice:

Don't let the browser automatically login to resources such as Illuminate or PowerSchool.

Entering the password manually each time is safer and less likely to get locked out.

WARNING

Know your passwords for Google, PowerSchool etc before clearing them

Q: Should I be doing this type of maintenance with my personal Google accounts too?

A: Yes, this type of browser maintenance is routinely recommended both professionally and personally.

Q: How often should you do this?

A: Quantity depends on individuals browsing habits.

Q: What can you expect after clearing your browsing data?

A: Expect online tools to prompt you to sign back in to your accounts and for the tools to operate more efficiently.
